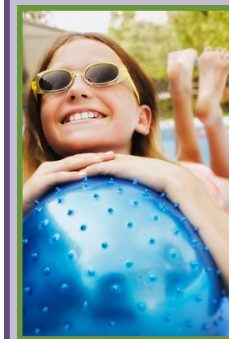

## **Strong Girls Strong Women Leadership Club**
