

Leadership Lorain County Internship Application Summer 2019

Student Eligibility Criteria:

Residency: Only applicants who maintain primary residence within Lorain County are eligible.

Graduation: High School Diploma

College/University Enrollment: Currently enrolled in an accredited college or university and having completed at least one year of college course work (entering your sophomore year), or graduated and enrolled in an advanced degree program.

**All applicants must be 18 + years old.

Intern Responsibilities before and during the program:

- Completion of the formal application form.
- Completion of an initial screening interview with the Internship Coordinator.
*Professional dress required.
- Completion of at least two interviews with an agency intern site supervisor.
*Professional dress required.
- Completion of the 10-week (up to 400 hour) internship experience.
 - ~ Intern is expected to work the same hours as his/her sponsoring agency.
 - ~ Any overtime, travel expenses, or holiday time is handled by the agency and may be paid or handled as "comp time".
- Mandatory attendance at the all-day Student Orientation on May 24th, 2019.
- Mandatory attendance at the 10 weekly intern meetings sponsored by LLC. The intern meetings provide an opportunity to learn more about Lorain County, gain leadership skills, and meet local leaders. Meetings and locations will be announced no later than Orientation. (Note that most meetings will take place during the work day. There will be at least one exception, where the weekly meeting will take place in the evening.)
- Students must have access to a car or other ways of reliable transportation.
- Interns must submit 10 weekly progress reports and time sheets to the Senior Intern in a timely manner.
- Interns must participate in the Internship Program's public service project.
- Interns are required to take part in the LLCIP evaluation process.
- Interns must attend the Recognition Celebration on August 1st, 2018.
- Vacations are highly discouraged. If you plan to be absent at any time throughout the program the dates must be submitted, in writing, in advance and agreed upon by both your site supervisor and the internship coordinator, understanding that any loss of hours may result in loss of pay.
- Your Intern site and/or LLC may require preliminary or random drug testing throughout the program.
- The 10-week internships must be completed between May 24, 2018, and August 9th, 2019.
